I. UP FOR DISCUSSION

- a. Plot boundaries and paths.
 - The stakes and paint have been ordered and will be available shortly to start this project.
- b. Waste disposal.
 - The committee have a suggested proposal for the council to allow tenants to remove all rubbish from their plots. If the council are willing to move forward more details will follow.
- c. Road / gate maintenance
 - This work should start in the Autumn when the workload for the council eases off.
- d. Ponds.
 - Tenants wanting to put new ponds on their plots will need to seek permission form the council.
- e. Rabbit and Hen policy.
 - This is on-going.
- f. New toilet.
 - The work to widen the door and provide a ramp should start in the next three weeks.
- g. Plot inspection results.
 - The second round of inspections for those tenants that failed the May inspections have been completed.
