### AGENDA DETAILS

#### I. UP FOR DISCUSSION

a. Plot inspections.

- The council have started contacting tenants following the recent plot inspections.

b. Plot numbers.

- There are still several plots without numbers. Displaying a visible number on your plot forms part of the tenancy agreement.

c. Plot boundaries

- The work has started to ensure all plots have clear boundaries and defined walkways between adjacent plots.

d. WTC survey.

- The survey has now finished, and the responses are being looked at. There were 162 responses.

e. Communal Bonfire.

- There will be a managed communal bonfire soon to begin eliminating rubbish from the site. Details to follow from the committee.

f. Rubbish disposal.

- The council is also looking to provide more skips for next year.  
Any rubble, bricks, stones, tiles, paving slabs can be added to the pile of rubble in the car park area by the main gate.  
The council have agreed in principle to the proposed waste collection area in the car park by the front gate. More details on how this will work to follow.

g. Hen and Rabbit policy.

- This is still a work in progress so currently tenants are not allowed to keep these animals on site.

h. Waiting list.

- There are 72 people on the waiting list.  
There are 15 vacant plots.
