#### I. UP FOR DISCUSSION

a. New noticeboard.

- Woodley Town Council budgets are to be agreed shortly so the committee should find out at the next council meeting if we will be getting our new notice board. If we do, we can then complete the work to make the entrance more welcoming to tenants and visitors.

b. Mini Digger.

- The mini digger has been delivered to the council and once the weather improves it will be used on various projects across the site. Some of these will involve road closures. The dates will be publicized once known.

c. Managed Bonfires.

- The committee have agreement from the council to have a managed bonfire once a week until the end of April. Can all tenants who have old, unwanted or rotten wood, branches or waste from pruning bring it to the area marked by red stakes by the back gate. d. Plot Viewings.

e. Plot inspections Policy

- The council's new inspections policy was ratified at the Leisure services committee meeting in January. The council will be sending out a communication shortly directing tenants to the policy.
