I. UP FOR DISCUSSION

a. The recycling area.

- All recycling has been paused for the foreseeable future. Unfortunately, a few tenants have taken advantage and there is a lot of broken glass across the area and more than a few metallic objects that did not originate from the allotments. The committee will pay for the glass to be removed but it is unlikely this will continue. The metal recycling could return at a future date as it is collected for free.

b. The Wilderness Explorers.

- These will be on site on Tuesday 7th July between the hours of 7.30-9.30. They have volunteered to carry out work across the site. This could be tidying plots where tenants are in poor health or on the communal areas. If any tenant has an idea of where they could be directed, please contact the committee.

c. Lock on the main gate.

- This is an intermittent issue but can be very distressing for tenants who can't get the lock to open. It is on the agenda for the next meeting with WTC. Hopefully we can work out a long-term solution to the issue.

d. Wildlife Warden.
