### I. UP FOR DISCUSSION

#### a. The new CCTV poles.

- The 2 new CCTV poles should be fixed into the ground in the next couple of weeks. A big thank you to Mr Grace for his help with this. Once this is done it shouldn't take long to attach the 2 poles required to get the height and then fix the cameras on top. This should go some way to making the site safer and more secure.

#### b. The Inspections.

- The re-inspections are scheduled for the end of June for those tenants who failed the May inspections. If any tenant failed the first set of inspections and is worried about the re-inspections, please contact the committee as soon as possible for advice. It was nice to have the best in row as part of the process and next year due to feedback from many tenants the May inspections will be carried out towards the end of the month rather than the middle.
