I. UP FOR DISCUSSION

a. Spare lock for main gate.

- WTC have given the committee a spare lock for the main gate so if it malfunctions out of office hours, we can change it and then the faulty lock can be returned to WTC when the office is next open.

b. The September inspections.

- These will take place the week beginning Monday 28th September. If any tenant has had any serious health issues which has prevented them from cultivating their plot, please contact the committee or WTC who may well give you a pass for this round of inspections.

c. Plot viewings.

- Caroline has been hard at work, and we have 11 new tenants to welcome into our community. There are still over 40 people on the waiting list with only 11 plots left for viewing.

d. Waste management.

- The committee is still in talks with WTC about how we can remove waste from the site. We have several ideas, but it will need some financial backing from WTC.

e. Water management.

- Thanks to everyone who filled in the questionnaire about water usage. There will be more detailed discussions in the coming weeks, but we are hoping to formulate a plan to collect rainfall for use by tenants during dry spells which hopefully will alleviate the pressure on the water tank system.

f. Launchpad.

- Launchpad continues to be popular with corporates which is great because the money earned from it will go to fund schemes like rubbish disposal and water collection.
